

7th Grade Supplies

**Be sure to label all of your supplies with your first and last name and your team!
You will need all of the supplies listed below.**

Language Arts

- 1 binder (1.5 - 2 inch) – label “Language Arts” and add loose leaf paper
- 1 Folder with holes labeled “Language Arts” - (Put this inside your binder)
- Dividers (5) – put in Language Arts binder

Science

- 1 One (1) inch Binder – label “Science” and add loose leaf paper
- 1 folder labeled Science (Put this in your binder)

Social Studies

- 1 Two & a half (2 1/2) inch binder – label “Social Studies” and add loose leaf paper (Doogan)
- At start of school check Mr. Jensen/Mr. Hyman’s website for supplies

Algebra

- 1 One and half inch binder– label “Algebra”
- 1 Graphing Notebook with 3 holes
- Graphing Calculator - recommended: Texas Instruments TI-84 – LABEL the calculator itself with your name!

Math & Replacement Math

- 1 One and a half inch binder – label “Math”
- Calculator - recommended: Texas Instruments TI-34II – LABEL the calculator itself with your name!

Study Skills

- One two pocket folder

ELL

- Electronic Bilingual dictionary – Label with your name
- 1 Binder (1 inch or 1.5 inch) – add loose leaf paper
- 2 Two pocket folder (Put this inside your binder)
- Dividers (5) – put in binder
